## **Customs Information Paper 48 (2016)**

### **Customs Freight Simplified Procedures (CFSP); additions to controlled goods**

<b>Who should read:</b>	CFSP authorisation holders and their representatives
<b>What is it about:</b>	New goods added to the CFSP controlled goods list to be declared using specific CFSP customs procedure codes
<b>When effective:</b>	1 August 2016
<b>Extant until/ Expires</b>	Ongoing

#### **1. Background**

Certain goods are considered to be controlled goods when they are declared using the CFSP declaration procedure. These controlled goods must be declared using specific Customs Procedure Codes (CPCs). Full details of the CPCs, including when they are to be used and what information is needed to complete the declaration can be found in Volume 3 of the UK Integrated Tariff.

#### **2. Goods which have been added to the list.**

The additional goods which are to be treated as controlled goods when you are using CFSP to declare them are shown below.

When you import goods which match the same commodity code, description and Country of Origin using CFSP you must comply with the controlled goods instructions and use the specific CPCs for controlled goods.

Combined Nomenclature Code	Description	Country of Origin
2514	Slate, whether or not roughly trimmed or merely cut, by sawing or otherwise, into blocks or slabs of a rectangular (including square) shape	China
2515	Marble, travertine, ecaussine and other calcareous monumental or building stone of an apparent specific gravity of 2,5 or more, and alabaster, whether or not roughly trimmed or merely cut, by sawing or otherwise, into blocks or slabs of a rectangular (including square) shape	China
2516	Granite, porphyry, basalt, sandstone and other monumental or building stone, whether or not roughly trimmed or merely cut, by sawing or otherwise, into blocks or slabs of a rectangular (including square) shape	China
6801	Setts, curb stones and flagstones, of natural stone (except slate)	China
6802	Worked monumental or building stone (except slate) and articles thereof, other than goods of heading 6801; mosaic cubes and the like, of natural stone (including slate), whether or not on a backing; artificially coloured granules, chippings and powder, of natural stone (including slate)	China
6803	Worked slate and articles of slate or of agglomerated slate	China
6908	Glazed ceramic flags and paving, hearth or wall tiles; glazed ceramic mosaic cubes and the like, whether or not on a backing	China
7210	Flat-rolled products of iron or non-alloy steel, of a width of 600 mm or more, clad, plated	China
