1. Introduction

ATA carnets may be used to temporarily import to or temporarily export goods from the United Kingdom.

The carnet replaces the normal customs declaration.

2. New Customs Procedure Code

In June we advised that a new CPC would be introduced for form C21 where an ATA Carnet is used at an inventory linked port/airport.

This is a reminder that with effect from 1 December the new CPC for goods exported (or re-exported) using an ATA carnet will be 10 00 052.
